Includes a historically important window, the "Good Sheppard" window, which was exhibited by Tiffany in the 1893 World Columbian Exposition as his masterpiece in stained glass. Early, to very late Tiffany windows, display the full range of design assembly techniques of Louis Comfort Tiffany.

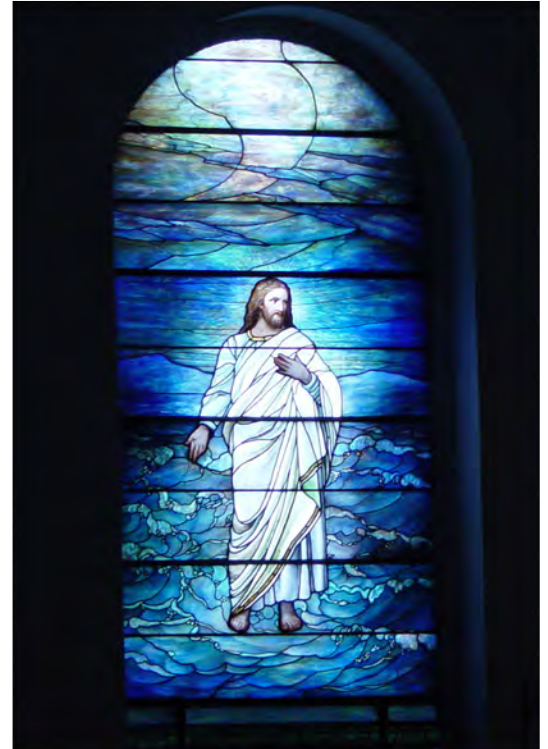
